



# The King's Awards for Enterprise in the Midlands Engine region

The King's Awards for Enterprise are the most prestigious awards for UK businesses, designed to recognise and encourage outstanding achievements in the fields of innovation, International Trade, Sustainable Development and Promoting Opportunity (through social mobility).

In the past 5 years, out of all 1,006 awards given out in the UK, the Midlands Engine region has received a total of **141 awards** (14% of the UK total). This shows the breadth and significance of our region's talent, with recipients varying in

size, sector, and location. Recipients of the King's Awards elevate the region and provide important investment, funding, grants and employment opportunities in the Midlands.

#### Businesses have won in all four categories



#### The national context

With 141 in total, the Midlands Engine<sup>1</sup> was the region which received the most awards outside of London and the South East.

The Midlands Engine region does especially well in the Innovation category compared to the UK as a whole (Figure 2).






Figure 1: Total King's and Queen's Awards by UK region, 2019-23




Figure 2: king's Awards Categories (%)



#### Which sectors are represented?

Most awards have been won by the Advanced Manufacturing sector, followed by the Business, Professional & Financial Services, Creative, Design & Digital and Retail/ Wholesale sectors.

The Advanced Manufacturing sector itself represents businesses producing a wide variation of innovative new products - from green technology for the marine industry, to garden furniture made from recycled plastic waste.




Figure 4: Location of award recipients
